REQUIREMENTS FOR FRESHMAN ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Students must be admitted to Park University's Parkville Daytime Campus Center to be awarded an academic scholarship. Deadline is February 1 for receipt of scholarship application and required documents. Scholarship funding is limited and will be awarded until funds are exhausted. Applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents.

A seventh semester high school transcript must be received before scholarships can be officially awarded. A student may not receive more than one academic scholarship.

Academic scholarships are available for fall and spring only, and will pay for a maximum of 30 credit hours per academic year. Students must be full-time to be eligible to receive an academic scholarship.

Trustee Scholarship (100 percent tuition)

Eligibility criteria: (2 of 3 required)

- 3.75 cumulative high school grade point average or 3200 GED score
- 28 ACT or 1860 SAT score
- Class rank in top 10 percent

Renewal criteria:

- Must maintain 3.5 GPA
- Available for a maximum of four years
- Must complete 24 credit hours each academic year (fall and spring)

President's Scholarship (50 percent tuition)

Eligibility criteria: (2 of 3 required)

- 3.5 cumulative high school GPA or 3000 GED score
- 26 ACT or 1760 SAT score
- Class rank in top 15 percent

Renewal criteria:

- Must maintain 3.25 GPA
- Available for a maximum of four years
- Must complete 24 credit hours each academic year (fall and spring)

Hundley-Volker Scholarship (25 percent tuition)

Eligibility criteria: (2 of 3 required)

- 3.25 cumulative high school GPA or 2800 GED score
- 24 ACT or 1650 SAT score
- Class rank in top 25 percent

Renewal criteria:

- Must maintain 3.0 GPA
- Available for a maximum of four years
- Must complete 24 credit hours each academic year (fall and spring)

A-Plus Scholarship (50 percent tuition)

Eligibility criteria:

- Attend an A-Plus-eligible high school (must provide a letter of eligibility from your high school counselor) AND
- 3.25 cumulative high school GPA OR
- 24 ACT or 1650 SAT score

Renewal criteria:

- Must maintain 3.25 GPA
- Available for a maximum of four years
- Must complete 24 credit hours each academic year (fall and spring)
