Campus Location

The 700-acre, flagship Parkville Campus rests high above the scenic Missouri River, less than a mile from historic Parkville, 10 minutes from downtown Kansas City and 15 minutes from Kansas City International Airport. Park also operates 42 Campus Centers in 21 states and Online.

Student Body

The Parkville Campus enrolls approximately 2,000 undergraduates representing 50 states and 105 countries. The average class size is 12, and the student-to-faculty ratio is 12:1. Park's global annual enrollment exceeds 25,000 students.

Academic Opportunities

Students pursue more than 50 undergraduate majors, everything from accounting to Spanish, and athletic training to theatre. Many innovative minors, certificate and graduate programs also are available.

Athletics

Park University is a member of the American Midwest Conference (AMC) in 14 of its 15 sports and in men's volleyball, Park is a member of the Mid-America Men's Volleyball Intercollegiate Conference (MAMVIC) West Division. Students enjoy an extensive intramural program.
