



## Malan/Templeton Scholarship

### Background

Although the Malan/Templeton Scholarship is not new, it has been recently endowed. The Malan/Templeton Scholarship is the gift of Harriss Cleland Malan, class of 1928. It was first established in 1991 by Malan and his wife, Fannie Bell, and has benefited a number of Park scholars. The Malans and Templetons have ties to the founding of the college, and various family members and friends have contributed to this scholarship in the last few years. Applicants for the Malan/Templeton scholarship must have a grade point average of 3.0, and be preparing for a vocation of teaching, medicine or religion.

### Selection Criteria

- Must be a junior or senior
- Minimum Cum G.P.A. of 3.0
- Preparing for a career in teaching, medicine, or religion
- Need for financial assistance
