Family Size - Includes the following:

- The student
- The student's parents, even if the student is not living with them
 - Exclude a parent who has died or is not living in the household because of separation or divorce.
 - Include a parent who is on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces living apart from the family.
- The student's siblings if the following are true:
 - They live with the student's parents (or live apart due to temporary absence – for example, college)
 - They receive more than half of their support from the student's parents, *and*
 - They will continue to receive more than half their support from the student's parents between 07/01/2025 and 06/30/2026
- Other persons if the following are true:
 - They live with the student's parents, and
 - They receive more than half of their support from the student's parents, and
 - They will continue to receive more than half their support from the student's parents between 07/01/2025 and 06/30/2026.

The provided criteria for "dependent children" or "other persons" match the IRS definition of people the parent could claim as a dependent on a U.S. tax return. *As a result, the parent should not include any unborn children in the family size.*
